English

Our poetry unit will be focussed around Monster Poems. The children will learn how to perform poems and then how to make up their own.
Our fiction unit will be based around the book The Story Blanket. We will be exploring traditional tales and fables.

Maths

In Maths we will be focussing on
Addition and Subtraction and then
moving on to 2D and 3D Shapes. We
will be naming shapes and
identifying their properties
We will also be learning to write
numbers as words and will continue
our journey towards 99 Club.

Science

Our focus in Science lessons will be on Seasonal Changes. Some of our science lessons will be linked to our Wild Tribe sessions where we will be making rain catchers and instruments that measure wind speed. The children will identify the four seasons and observe the changes that happen throughout autumn and winter. Elements of this science topic will be revisited in spring and summer.

Geography

In Geography we will be building on our previous topic and looking at what is special about where we live. We will visit Trethevy Quoit and make observations about our local, including the human and physical features.

We will learn some basic map skills and identify where we live on a map.

Art

In Art we will be developing our painting skills. We will learn about primary colours and how we can mix them to create secondary colours. We will then learn to adjust tone and shade by adding white or black to colours. Our focus artist will be Andy Warhol. We will create a pop art style picture using a Cornish theme.

What is special about where we live?



PE

This term we will be learning how to perform simple moves in gymnastics. We will learn how to tuck and roll safely. We will also be learning how to use equipment safely and with good control.

Music

In Music we will be learning how to accompany a song with percussion instruments. We will also be learning how to follow a pattern, keep rhythm and hold a steady beat. We will be learning Christmas songs ready for our Nativity performance.
